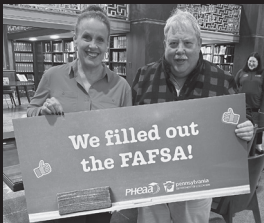
THANK YOU, FIRST RESPONDERS

LEGISLATIVE **ACTION:**

Bills to Move PA Forward

The 2025-26 session is officially underway, and members are introducing bills that work toward solutions to Pennsylvania's most pressing issues. I am proud to sponsor the following bills and look forward to introducing more throughout the session.

House Bill 519 would create a building code official "trainee" program.

House Bill 520 would allow licensed organizations under the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act to have social card games on their premises.

House Bill 521 would reform Alimony Pendente Lite (APL) to provide for more fairness in the divorce process.

House Bill 523 would protect police officers effectuating arrests.
